Contest Rules

- 1. Participants must write on the official topic.
- 2. Essay must be written in English. Contestants may submit only one essay entry.
- 3. Each entry must include a Cover Page with the Title of the Contest, name, grade, address and school attending on it. Each page must be numbered.
- 4. Essays must be typewritten, double-spaced with the contestant's name, grade, address and school attending in the header, and must be the author's original work.
- 5. Essay must be a minimum of 300 words but no more than 500 words. The title, bibliography or footnotes are not counted in the word limit.

- 6. Essays will be judged on material organization, vocabulary and style, grammar, punctuation, spelling, neatness, and adherence to contest rules.
- 7. The winning essay will be published.
- 8. The decision of the ICA Board will be final.
